We ask that you arrive in Glenville on **Friday, June 18th between 10:30am and 12:00pm** to register at **Pickens Hall**. Pickens Hall is located on the GSC Main Campus on Court Street directly across from the Gilmer County Court House Annex. Pickens Hall offers the following amenities:

- Dormitory style accommodations in four-bedroom air conditioned suites. Each bedroom in each suite has two single beds. As the official companion, you will be rooming with the Belle that you are accompanying.
- Linens, including towels and washcloths, are provided.
- One private bathroom in each suite.
- One refrigerator and microwave in each room.

In order to make your stay more comfortable, you should bring the following:

- All toiletries including soap and shampoo. These are not provided.
- Comfortable walking shoes.
- Drinks and snacks, if desired (no alcoholic beverages).
- Instant coffee and/or tea bags and a microwaveable cup if you would like to make hot beverages in your room.
- Sunscreen.
- Sunglasses.
- Umbrella or other rain gear.
